1. Trace all the shapes to steam-a-seam. Trace the antler a second time, but mirrored
2. Cut roughly around the shapes.
3. Stick the steam-a-seam to the back of the fabric and cut along the lines.
4. Stick the fabric pieces to your block and press.
5. Secure the pieces with a blanket stitch or small zig zag.
