

A simple block turn into a very intersting quilt with the Follow Me quilt. This quilt has endless posibilities once you start playing with the direction and distribution of the arrows.

The arrow block is a perfect beginner FPP block. What is your favorite method for Foundation Paper Piecing? I love to use Freezer Paper when making a ton of the same blocks.

Fabric Requirements

Here are the fabric requirements for the Follow Me quilt.

•	Picture Perfect Ligt Teal	1/2 yd
•	Brushes Teal	1/2 yd
•	Tring-a-ling Dark Teal	1/2 yd
•	Happy Quilting Light Blue	1/2 yd
•	Tea Please Blue	1/2 yd
•	Planty Friends Dark Blue	1/2 yd
•	Bubble Bath Green	1/2 yd
•	Mail Day Green	1/2 yd
•	Planty Friends	1/2 yd
•	Dot Dot Green/Teal	6 yard

For the **binding** I used 3/4 yard of the Octagon Stripe in Teal/Green. For the **backing** of the quilt I used 2 1/4 yard of the double wide Happy Quilting backing in teal.



Cutting Fabric

The **Follow Me** quilt is made with 80 arrow blocks. Make 9 blocks with each fabric listed in the requirements. You only need to make 8 blocks out of the green Mail Day fabric.


Cut the following pieces and strips for the border and white spaces from the Dot Dot background fabric. All measurements below include 1/4 inch seam allowance.

A 8 times 6 1/2 x 6 1/2 inch
B 7 times 12 1/2 x 6 1/2 inch
C 2 times 18 1/2 x 6 1/2 inch
D 2 times 72 1/2 x 6 1/2 inch
E 2 times 66 1/2 x 6 1/2 inch

The Pattern


The Follow Me pattern is a FPP pattern. When printing the pattern keep these things in mind:

- Print the pattern true to size. Choose 'no scaling' or '100%' in your printer settings.
- Check the I inch box on the first page of the pattern to see if you're printing the pattern to the correct size.
- A FPP pattern always is the mirrored image of the end result.





Follow me - Coloring page







Follow Me Quilt - Assembly

To assemble the quilt top you will take your blocks and sashing pieces and join them like this:

- All pieces should be sewn with a 1/4 inch seam allowance.
- Place your blocks and **A**, **B**, **C** pieces on a design wall, a bed or other large surface.
- Play with the directions of the arrows and the find your preferred layout.
- First join all the rows, from left to right, following the order you see in the illustration below.
- Then you can sew the **D** strips to the sides and the **E** strips to the top and bottom.

And there you have your quilt top finished!
