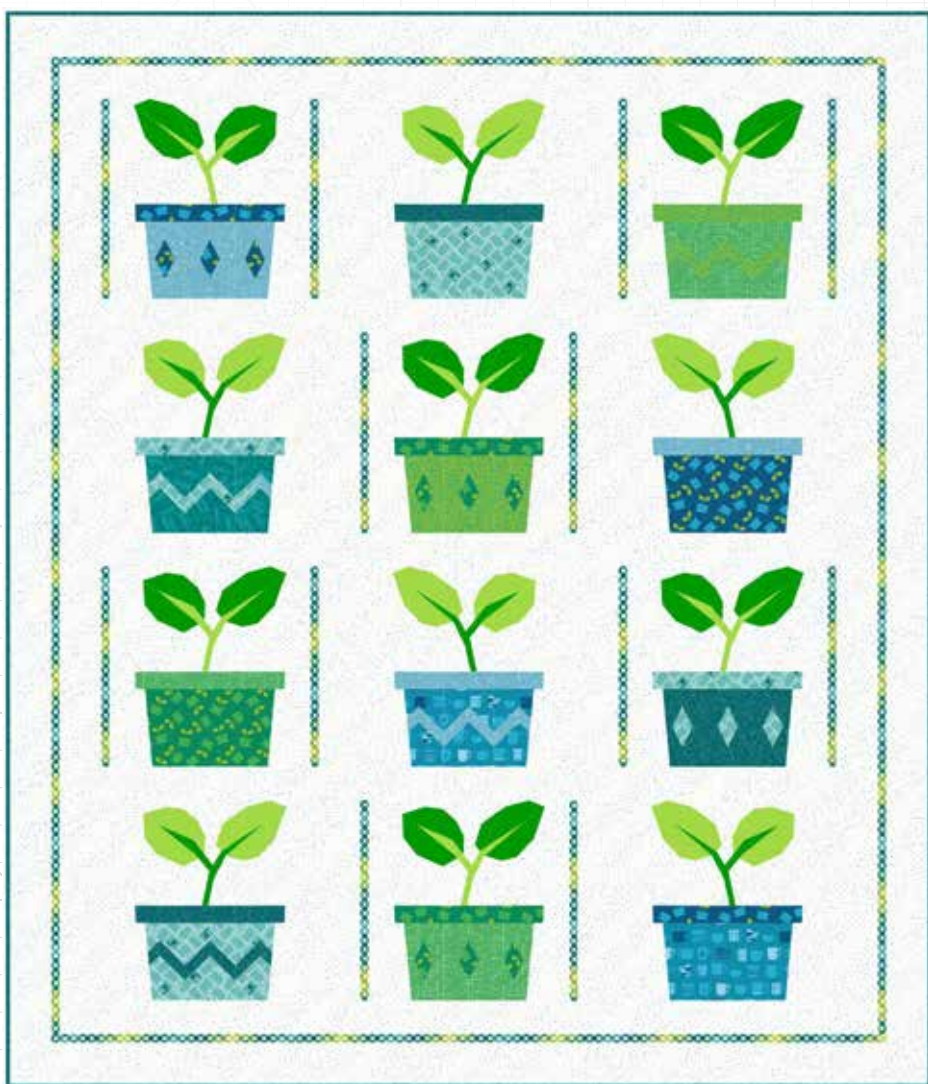

## Size

Crib 33 x 44 inch  
Throw 55 x 64 inch

# Planty Friends

Fresh, green plants. New leaves growing. Such a happy spring quilt!  
The Planty Friends quilt comes in two sizes, a crib (33 x 44") and throw (48 x 56").

In this Pattern you will find the fabric requirements for both sizes, the printing instructions for the pattern and how to assemble the blocks and quilt.

## Foundation Paper Piecing

This pattern is a Foundation Paper Piecing (FPP) pattern. Want to become more confident in FPP with freezer paper, normal printing paper and tea bag paper? Take a look at my online course on FPP.

## Fabric Requirements

Here are the fabric requirements for the crib and the throw size quilt

•	Leafs	Superior Solids Kelly Green	1 FQ	1/2 yd
•	Leafs	Superior Solids Lime	1 FQ	1/2 yd
•	Pots	Picture Perfect Light Teal	1 FE	1 FQ
•	Pots	Brushes Teal	1 FE	1 FQ
•	Pots + Binding	Tring-a-ling Dark Teal	3/4 yd	1 yd
•	Pots	Happy Quilting Light Blue	1 FE	1 FQ
•	Pots	Tea Please Blue	1 FE	1 FQ
•	Pots	Planty Friends Dark Blue	1 FE	1 FQ
•	Pots	Bubble Bath Green	1 FE	1 FQ
•	Pots	Mail Day Green	1 FE	1 FQ
•	Pots	Planty Friends	1 FE	1 FQ
•	Sashing	Octagon stripe Green/Teal	1 FE	1/2 yd
•	Background	Dot Dot Green/Teal	1 3/4 yd	4 yd

The **binding** is included in the fabric requirements above. For the **backing** of the quilt I used Planty Friends in Dark blue. You will need 1 1/2 yard for the crib quilt and 3 3/4 yard for the throw quilt.

## Cutting the Sashing

The **crib quilt** is made of 6 plant blocks and sashing. Here's a list of the sashing we need to cut before you make the blocks. All the measurements include 1/4 inch seam allowance.

- **A** 3 times 12 1/2 x 3 inch Dot Dot Green/Teal
- **B** 6 times 12 1/2 x 3 1/2 inch Dot Dot Green/Teal
- **C** 6 times 12 1/2 x 1 inch Octagon Stripe Gree/Teal
- **D** 4 times 34 x 2 1/2 inch Dot Dot Green/Teal

For the **throw quilt** is made with 12 plant blocks. We will need the following for sashing in this quilt.

- **A** 4 times 12 1/2 x 3 inch Dot Dot Green/Teal
- **B** 12 times 12 1/2 x 3 1/2 inch Dot Dot Green/Teal
- **C** 6 times 12 1/2 x 1 inch Octagon Stripe Gree/Teal
- **E** 5 times 49 1/2 x 2 1/2 inch Dot Dot Green/Teal
- **F** 2 times 58 1/2 x 1 inch Octagon Stripe Gree/Teal
- **G** 2 times 50 x 1 inch Octagon Stripe Gree/Teal
- **H** 2 times 59 x 3 inch Octagon Stripe Gree/Teal
- **I** 2 times 55 1/2 inch Octagon Stripe Gree/Teal

## The Pattern

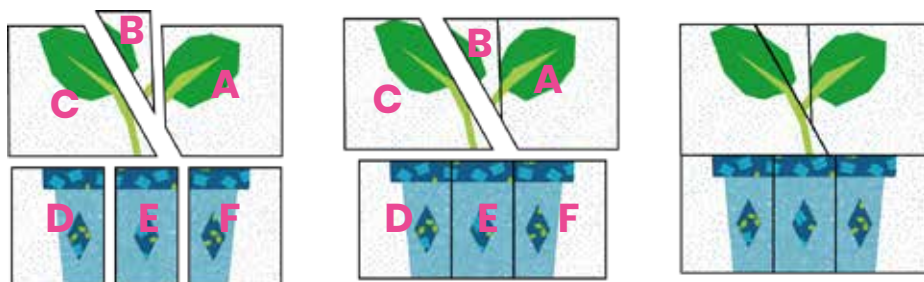
The Plant Friends pattern is a FPP pattern. When printing the pattern keep these things in mind:

- Print the pattern true to size. Choose 'no scaling' or '100%' in your printer settings.
- Check the 1 inch box on the first page of the pattern to see if you're printing the pattern to the correct size.
- A FPP pattern always is the mirrored image of the end result.

## Block assembly

To assemble a block start with sewing the pot together (only for pot 2 and 3). Then join the leaves following the illustration below.

Then the pot can be joined with the leaves.





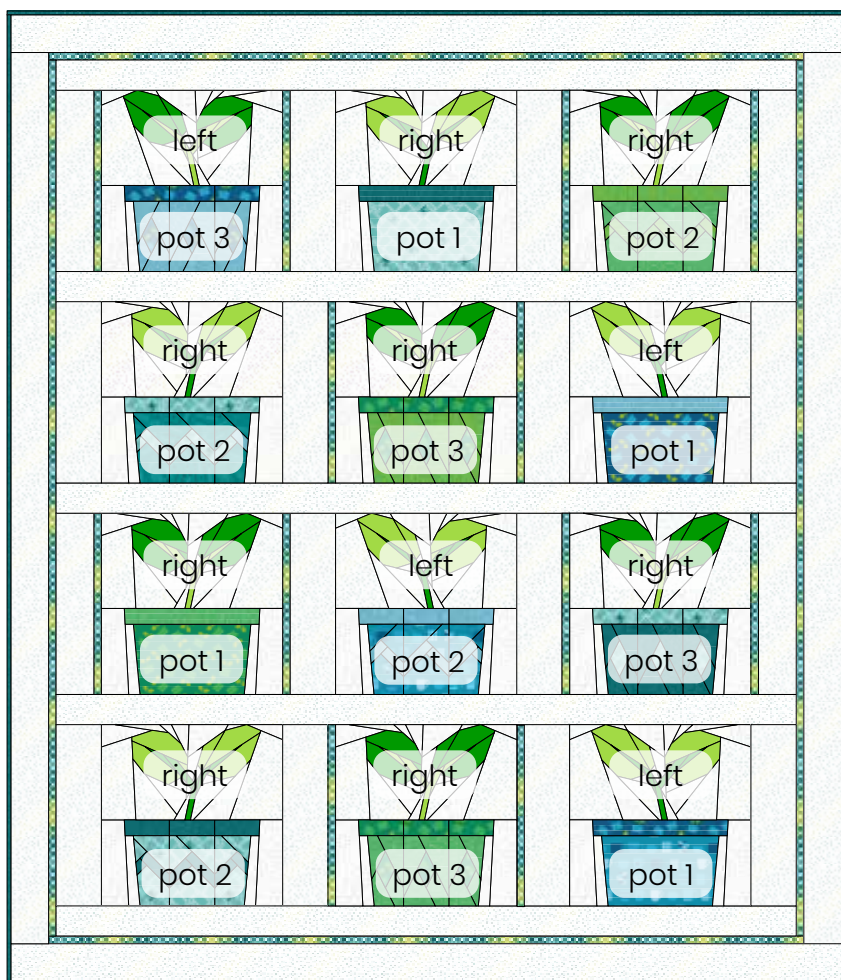
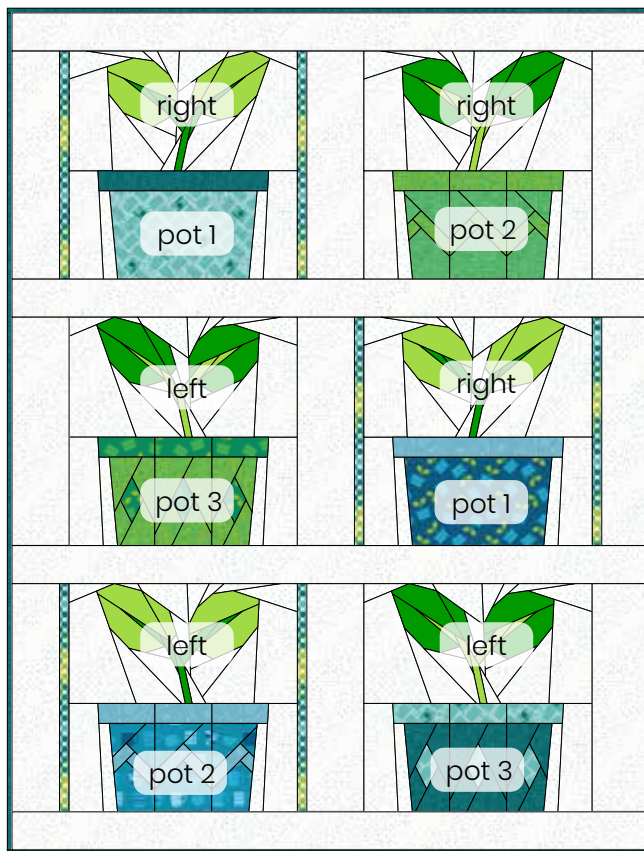
## Making the blocks

Each block consists of a leaf part (left or right) and a pot (three different options). On this page you'll find which blocks you'll need to make for the crib and the throw quilt

For the **throw quilt** you will make the following sections:

- 2 times    Leafs Left    Dark green
- 1 times    Leafs Right    Dark green
- 1 times    Leafs Left    Light green
- 2 times    Leafs Right    Light green
- 2 times    Pot 1
- 2 times    Pot 2
- 2 times    Pot 3

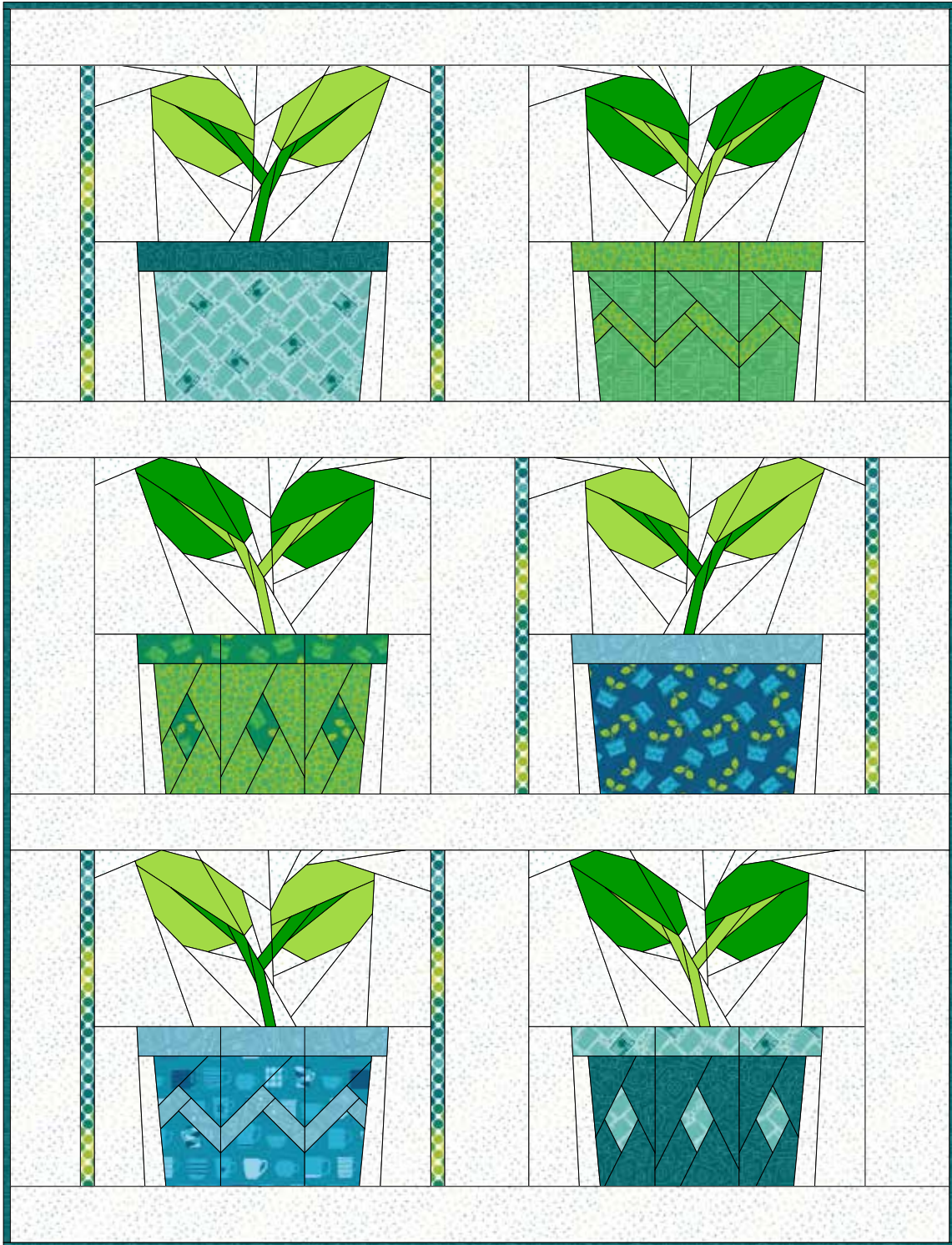
The images on the next page will show you which fabric to use where.



For the **throw quilt** you will make the following sections:

- 1 times    Leafs Left    Dark green
- 5 times    Leafs Right    Dark green
- 3 times    Leafs Left    Light green
- 3 times    Leafs Right    Light green
- 4 times    Pot 1
- 4 times    Pot 2
- 4 times    Pot 3

# Planty Friends Quilt - Crib size



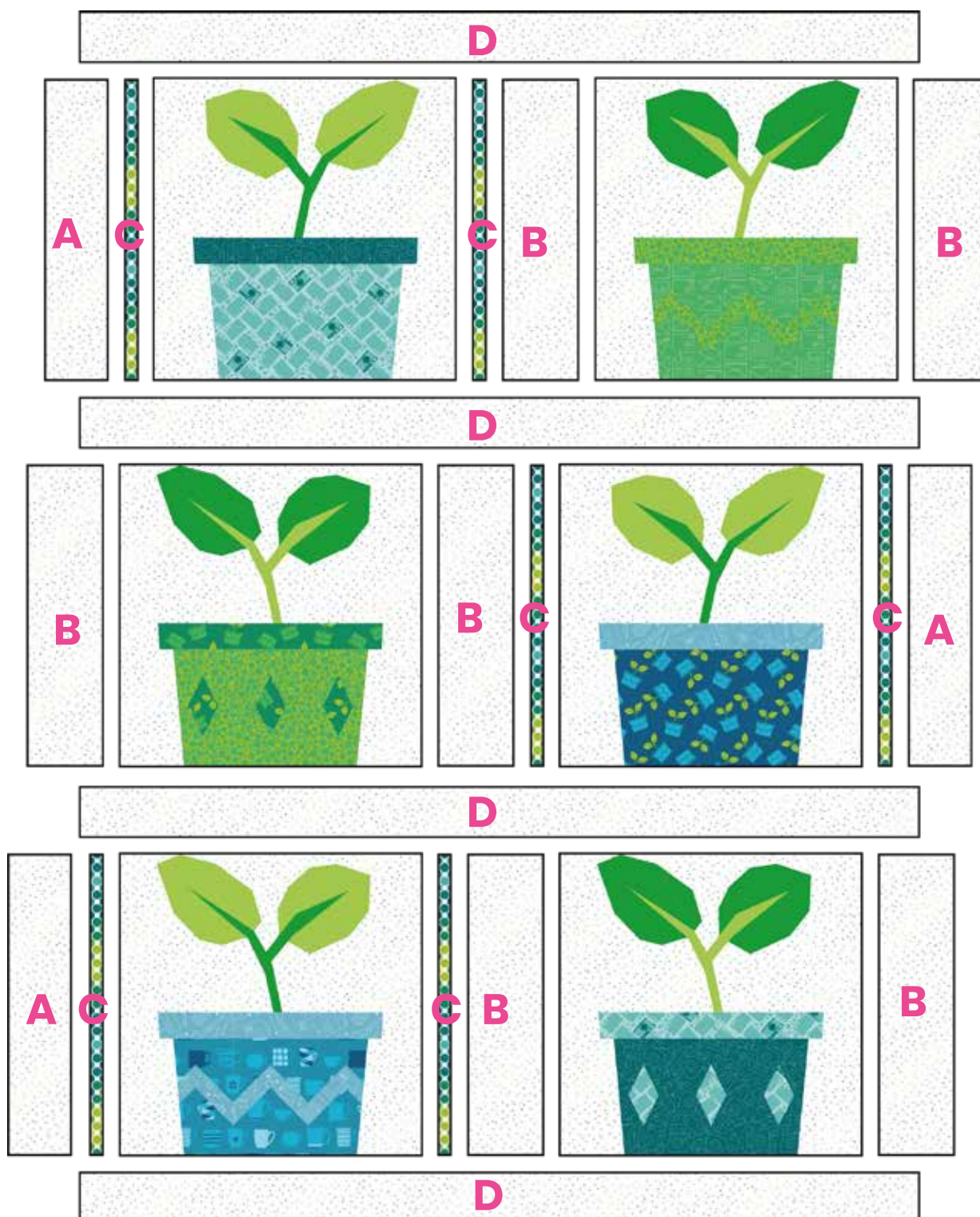


## Planty Friends Quilt - Crib size - Assembly

To assemble the quilt top for the CRIB quilt you will take your blocks and sashing pieces and join them like this:

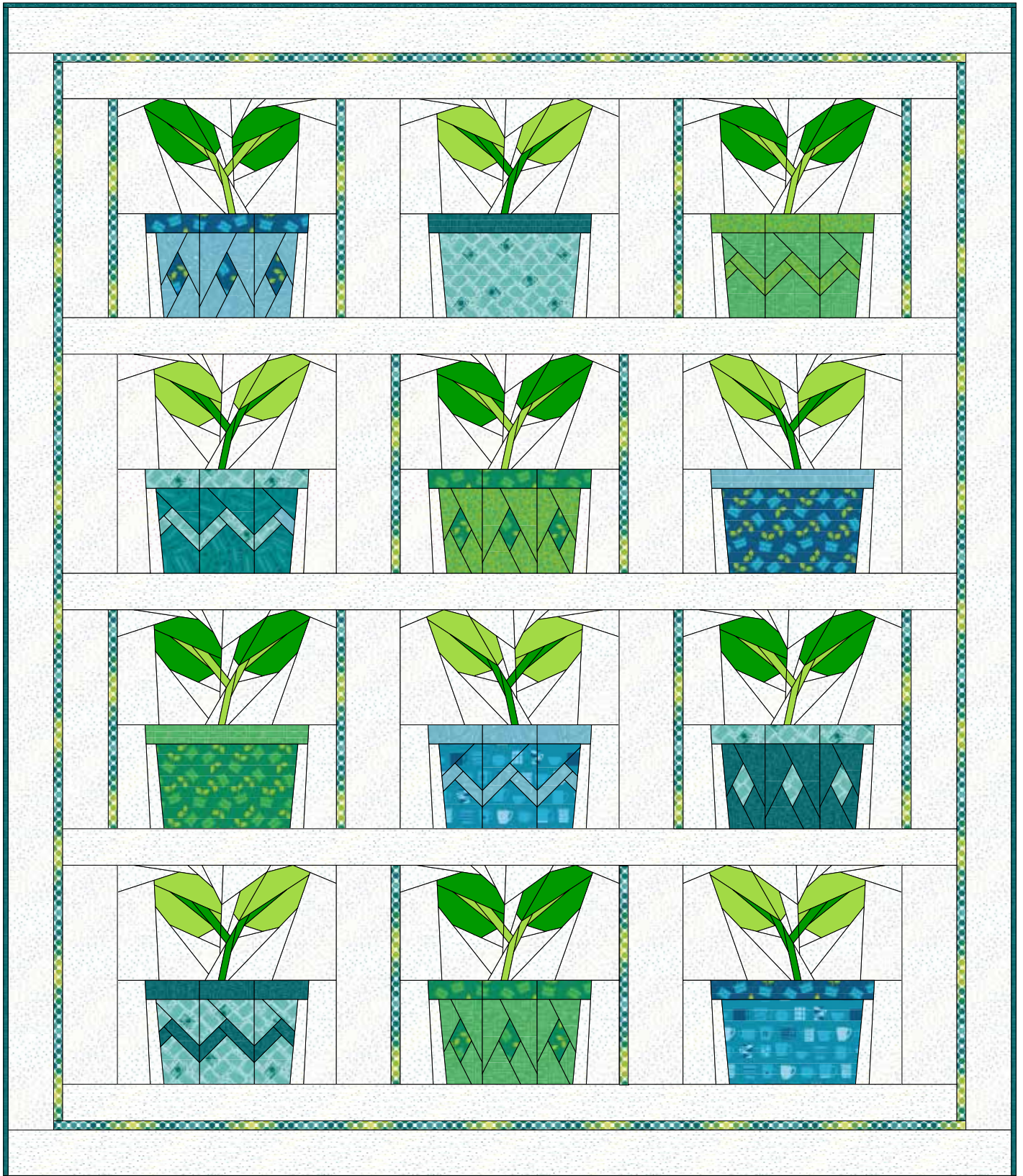
- All pieces should be sewn with a 1/4 inch seam allowance.
- First join all the rows, following the order you see in the illustration below.
- With all the rows assembled you can sew the D strips inbetween, above and below the rows.

And there you have your quilt top finished!

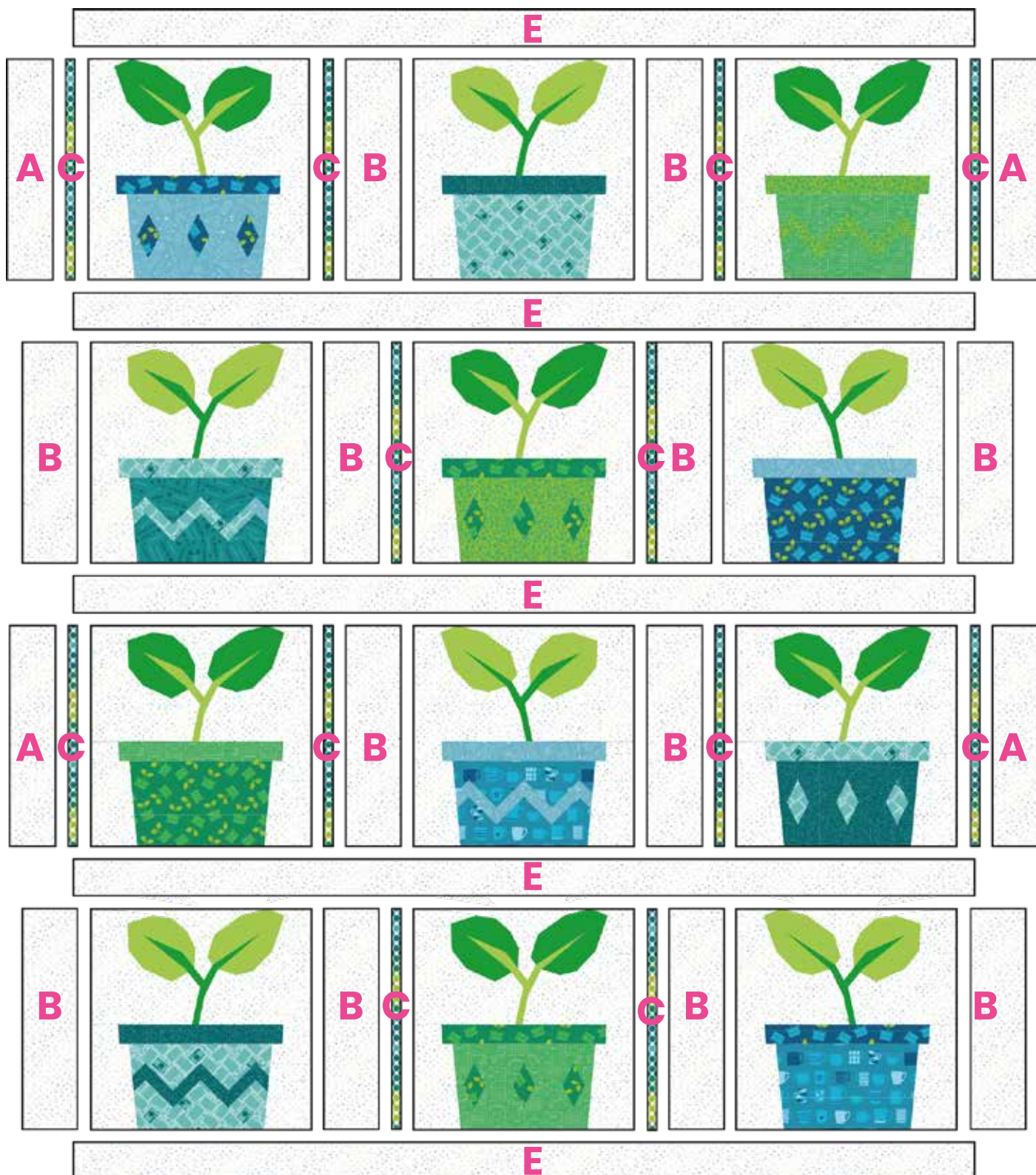




## Planty Friends Quilt - Throw size - Assembly

To assemble the quilt top for the THROW quilt you will take your blocks and sashing pieces and join them like this:

- All pieces should be sewn with a 1/4 inch seam allowance.
- First join all the rows, following the order you see in the illustration below.
- With all the rows assembled you can sew the E strips inbetween, above and below the rows.

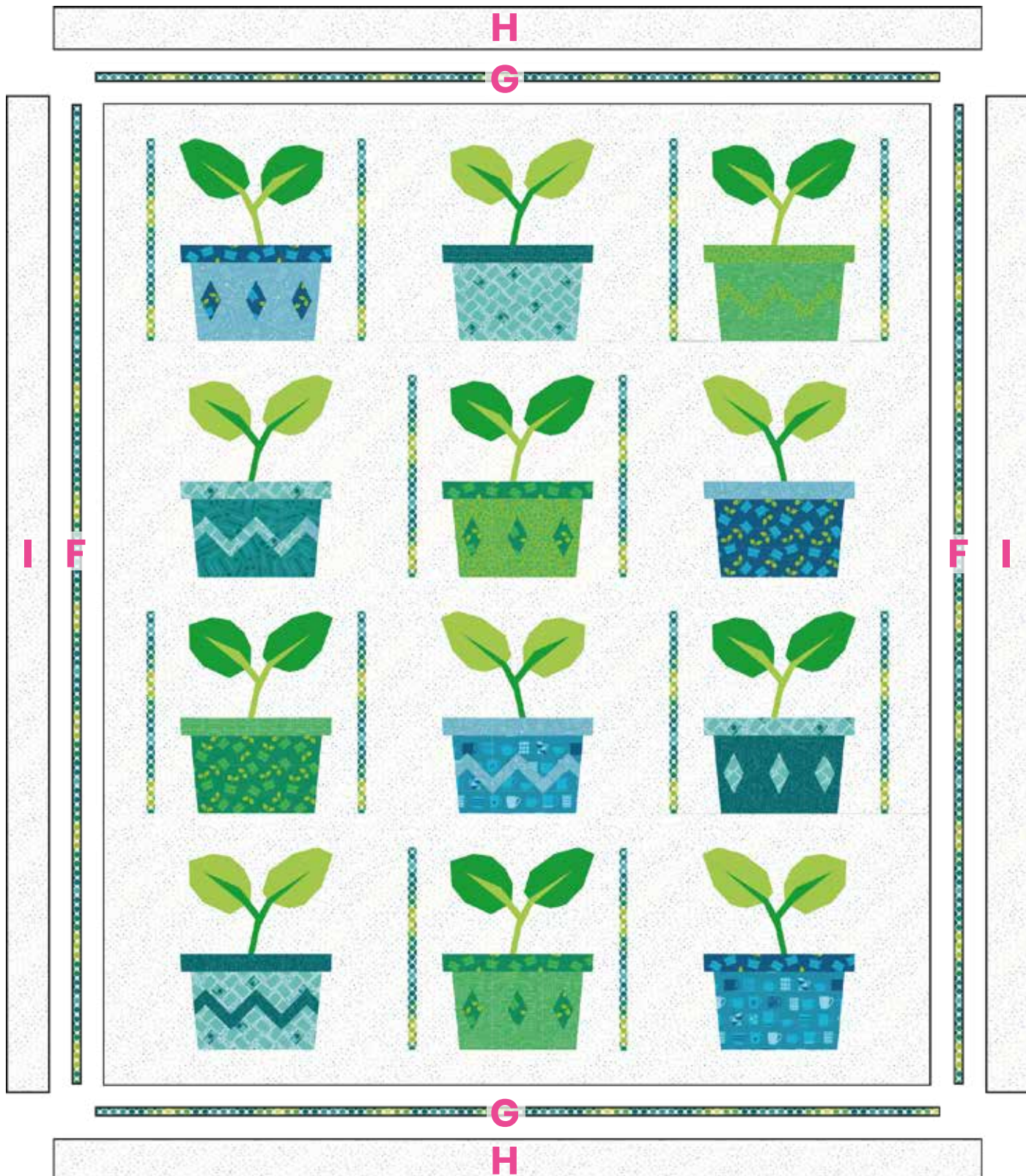




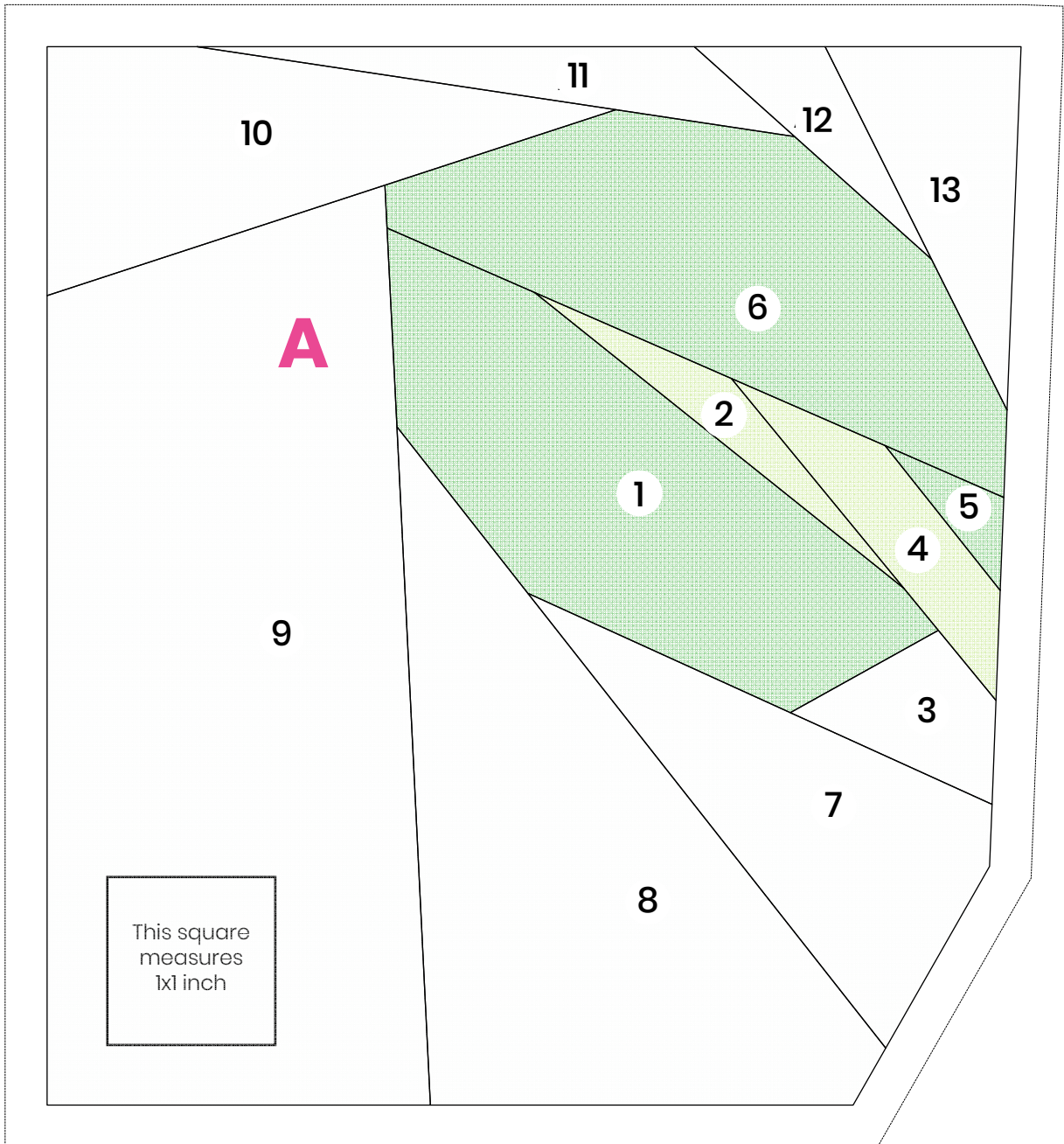
Now it's time to sew the borders around the quilt.

- Start by sewing the F strips to the sides of the quilt.
- Next up are the G strips that go to the top and bottom
- Then the I strips go to the sides of the quilt,
- And finally the H strips to to the top and bottom of the quilt.

And there you have your Planty Friends Throw quilt finished!

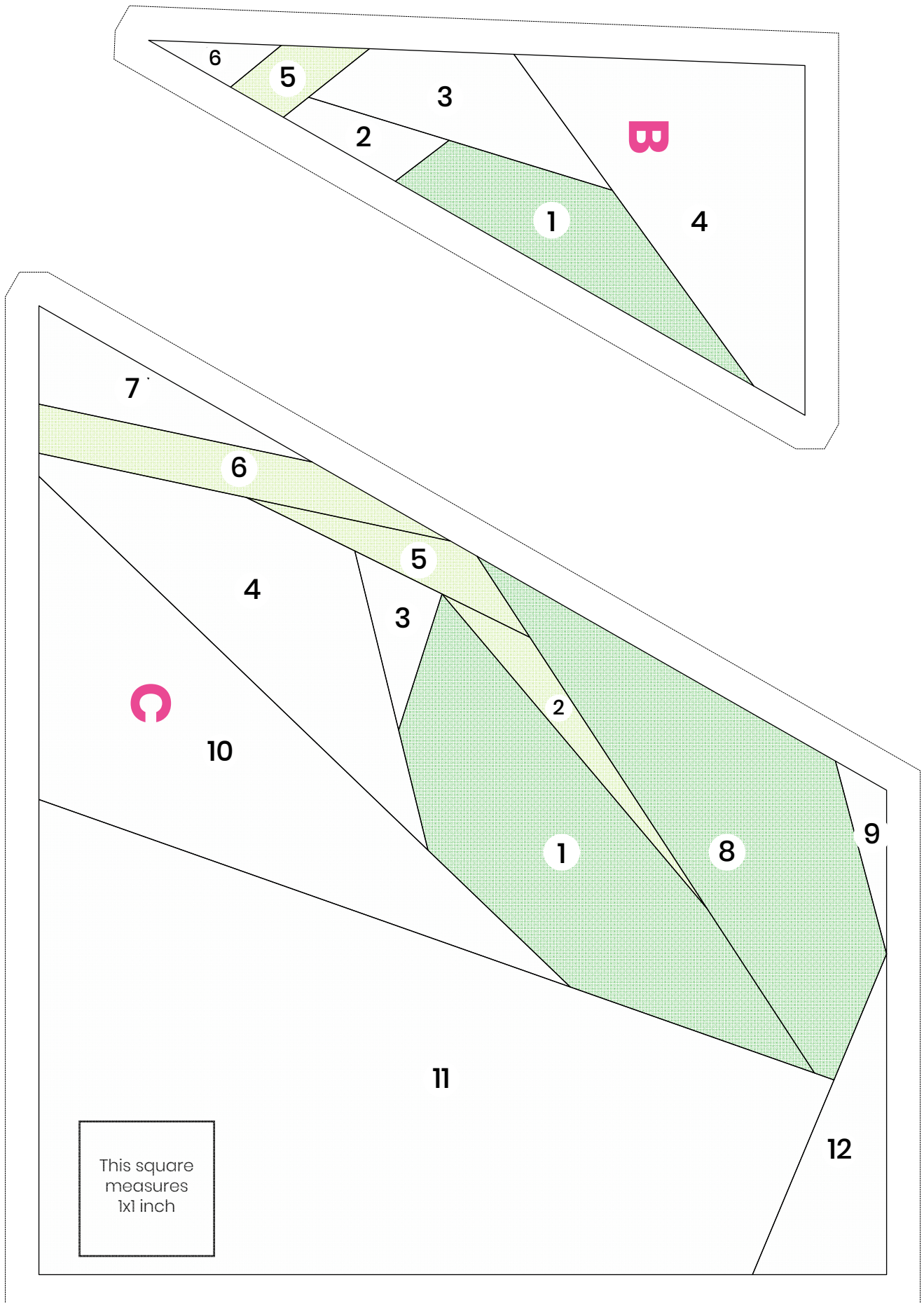


# Leafs Left (1/2)

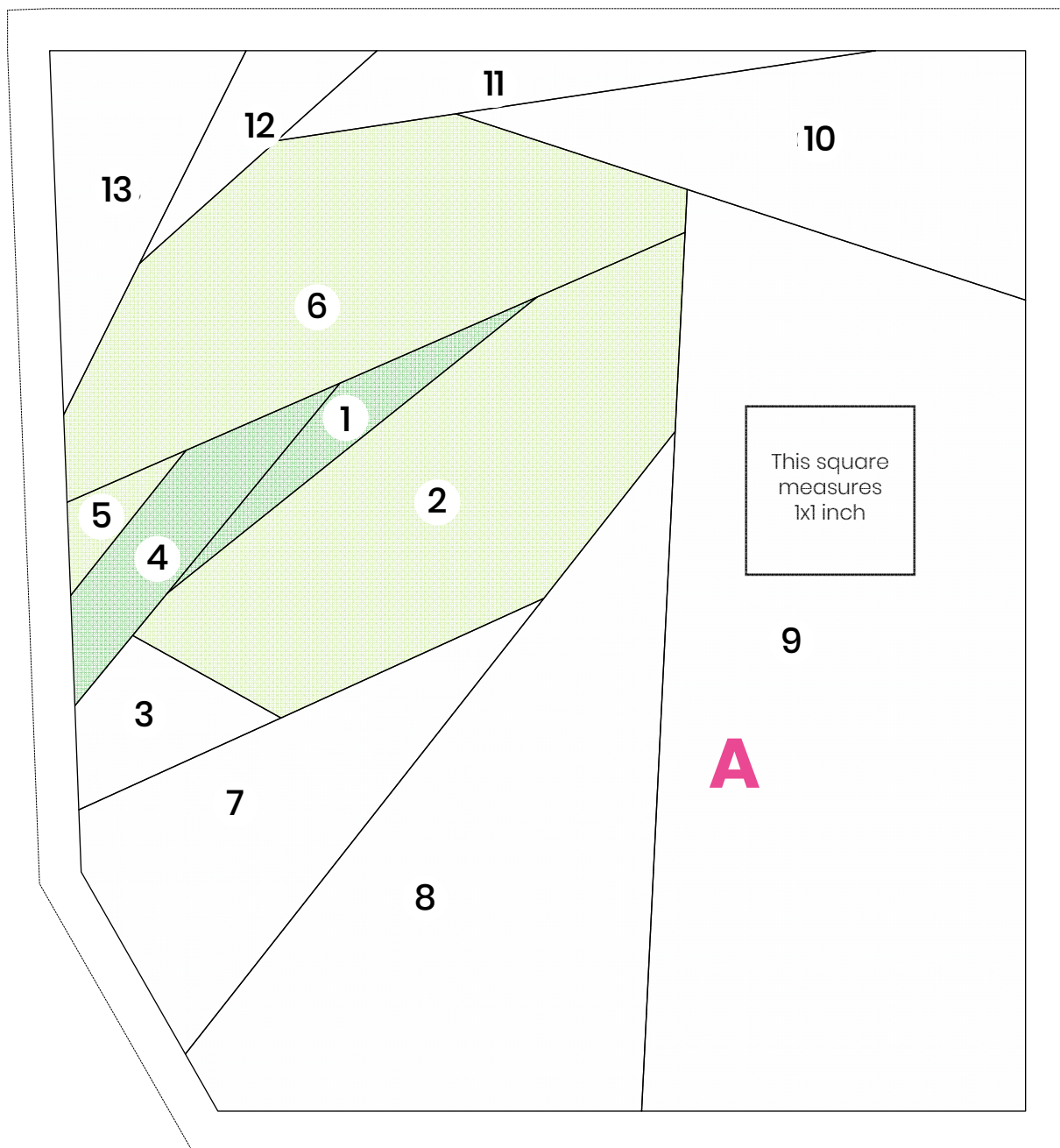




## Leafs Left (2/2)

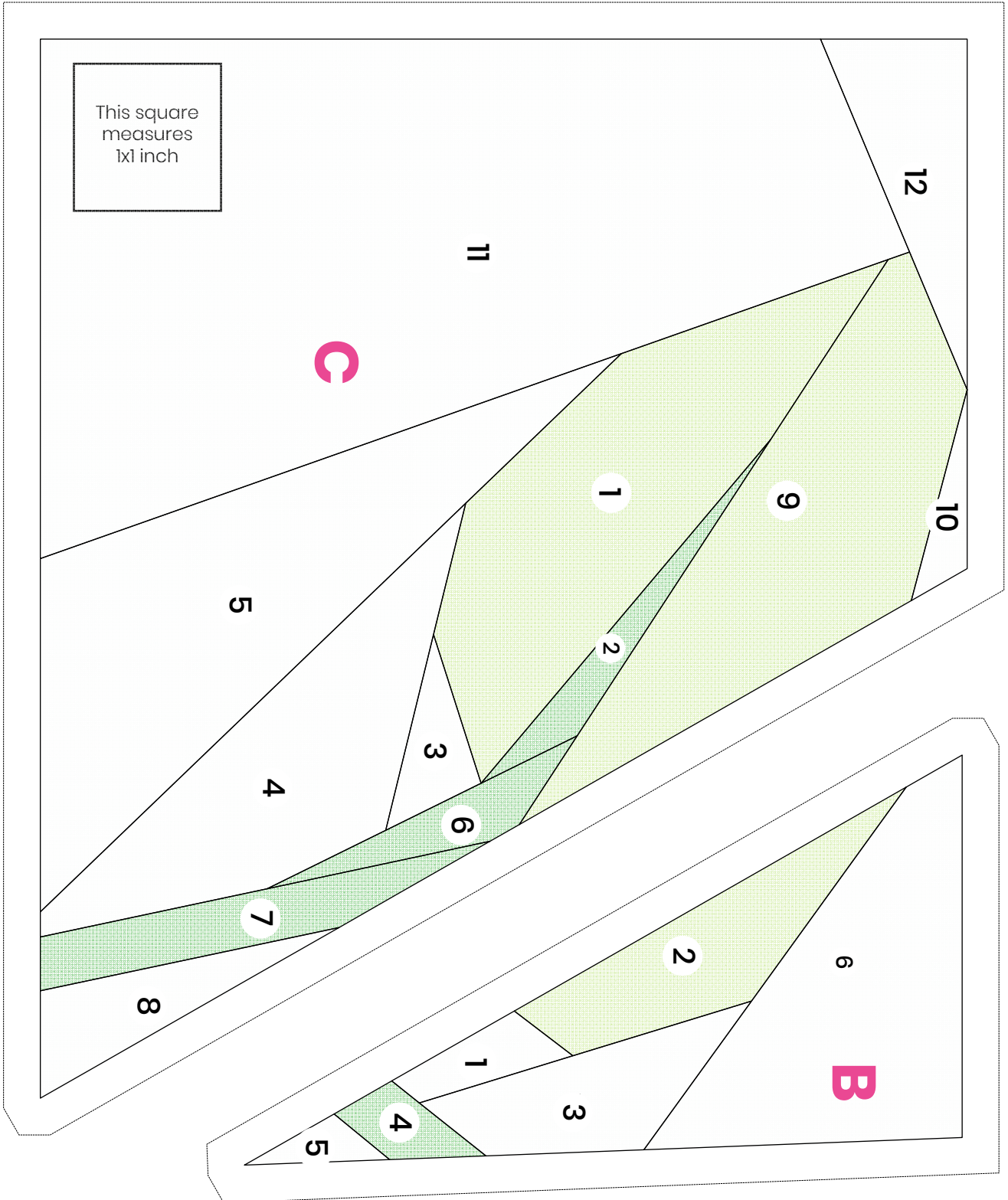


# Leafs Right (1/2)



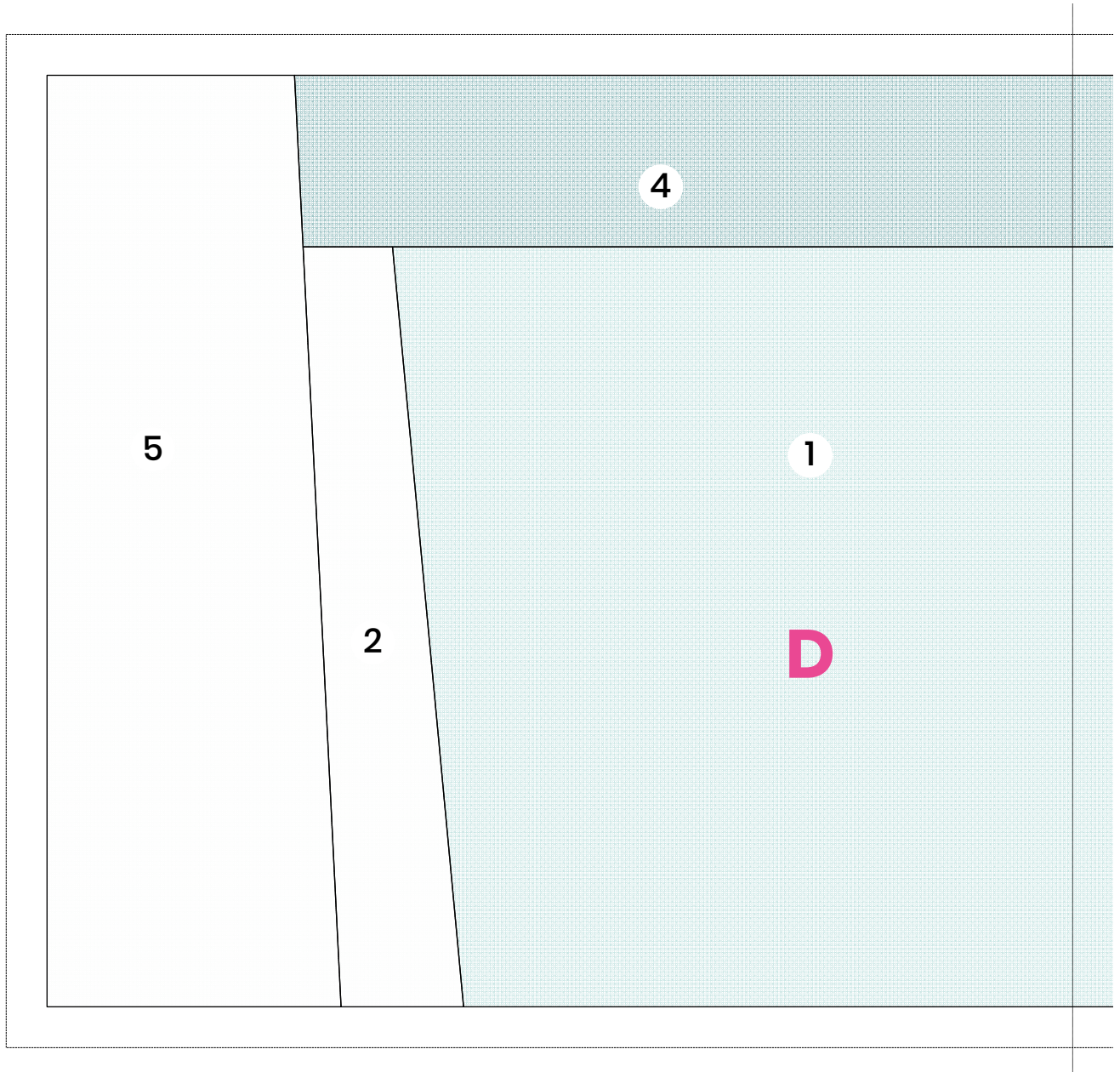

# Flower Pot 1 (1/2)

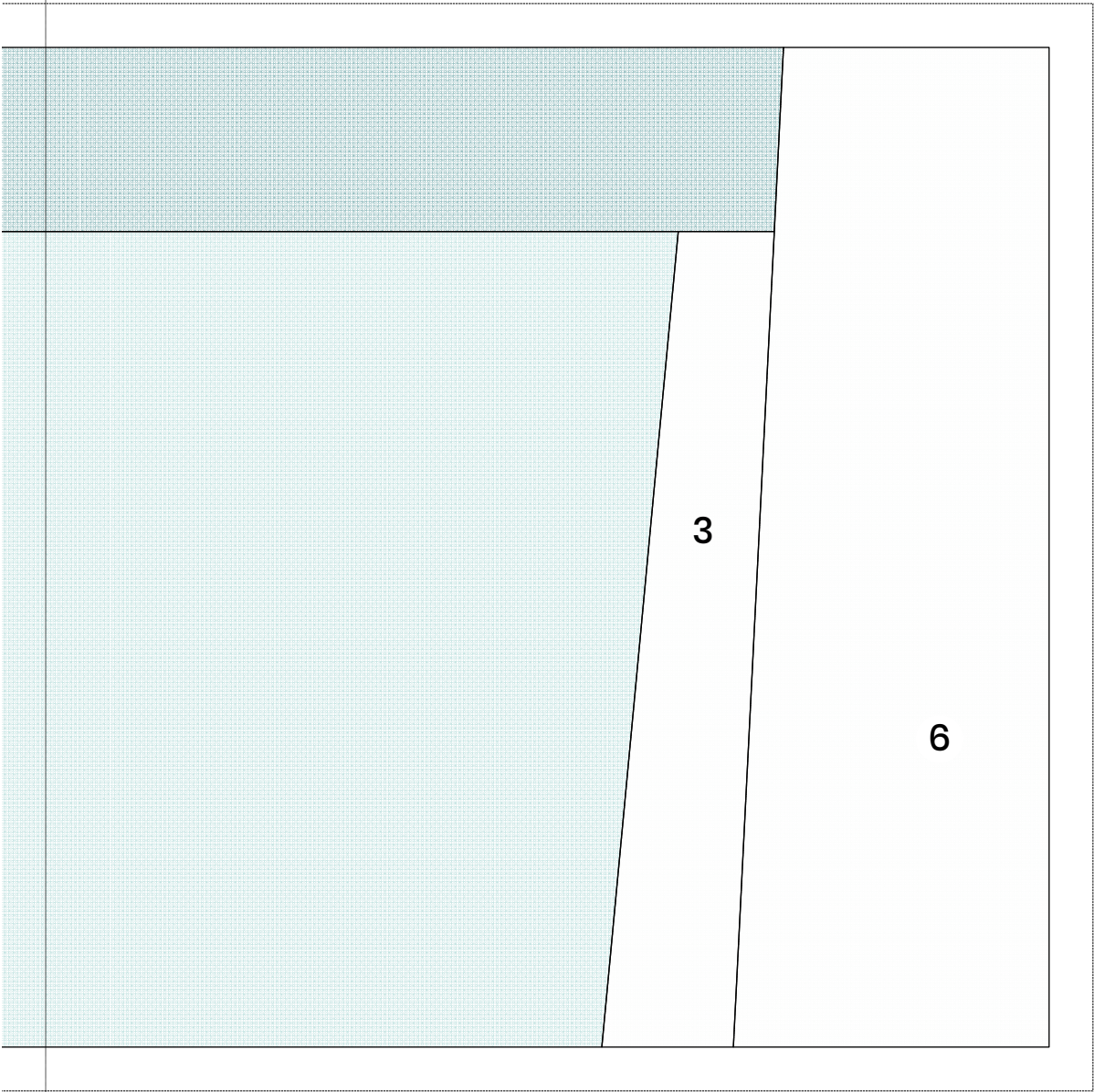

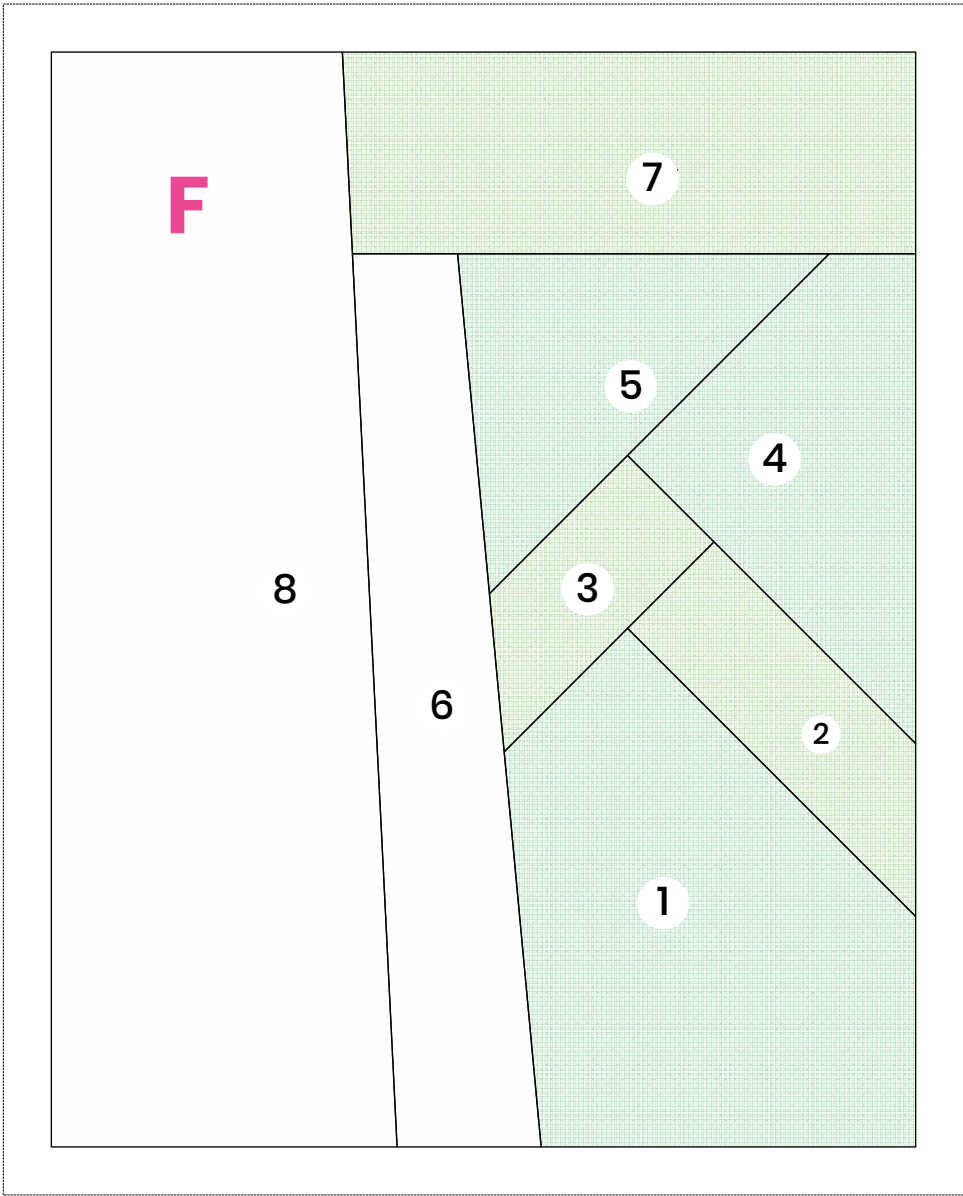
# Flower Pot 1 (2/2)

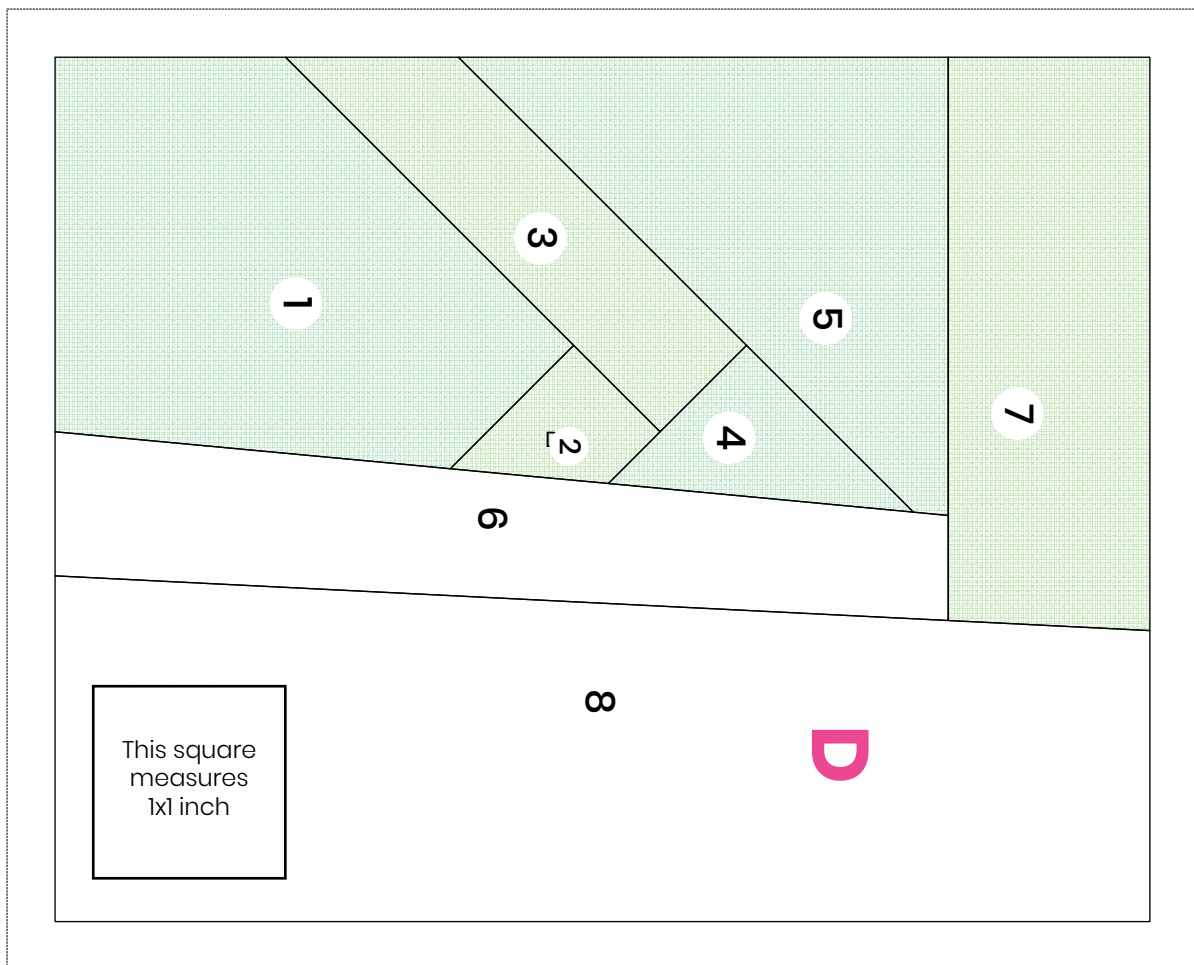
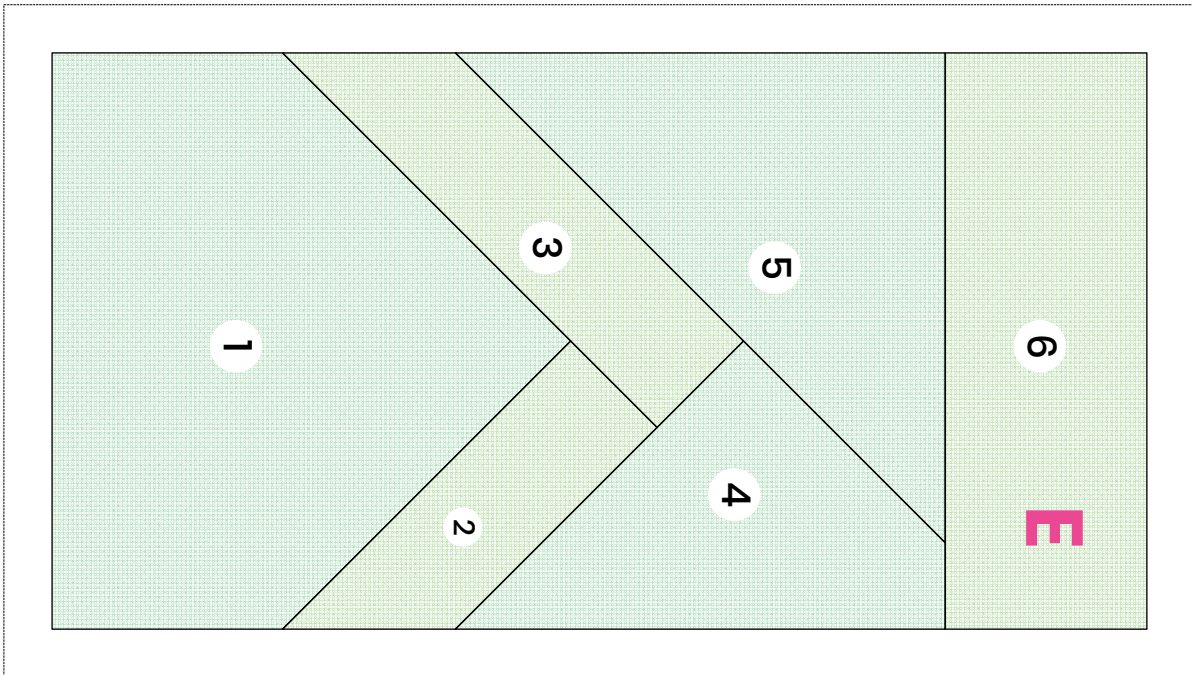
# Flower Pot 2 (1/2)

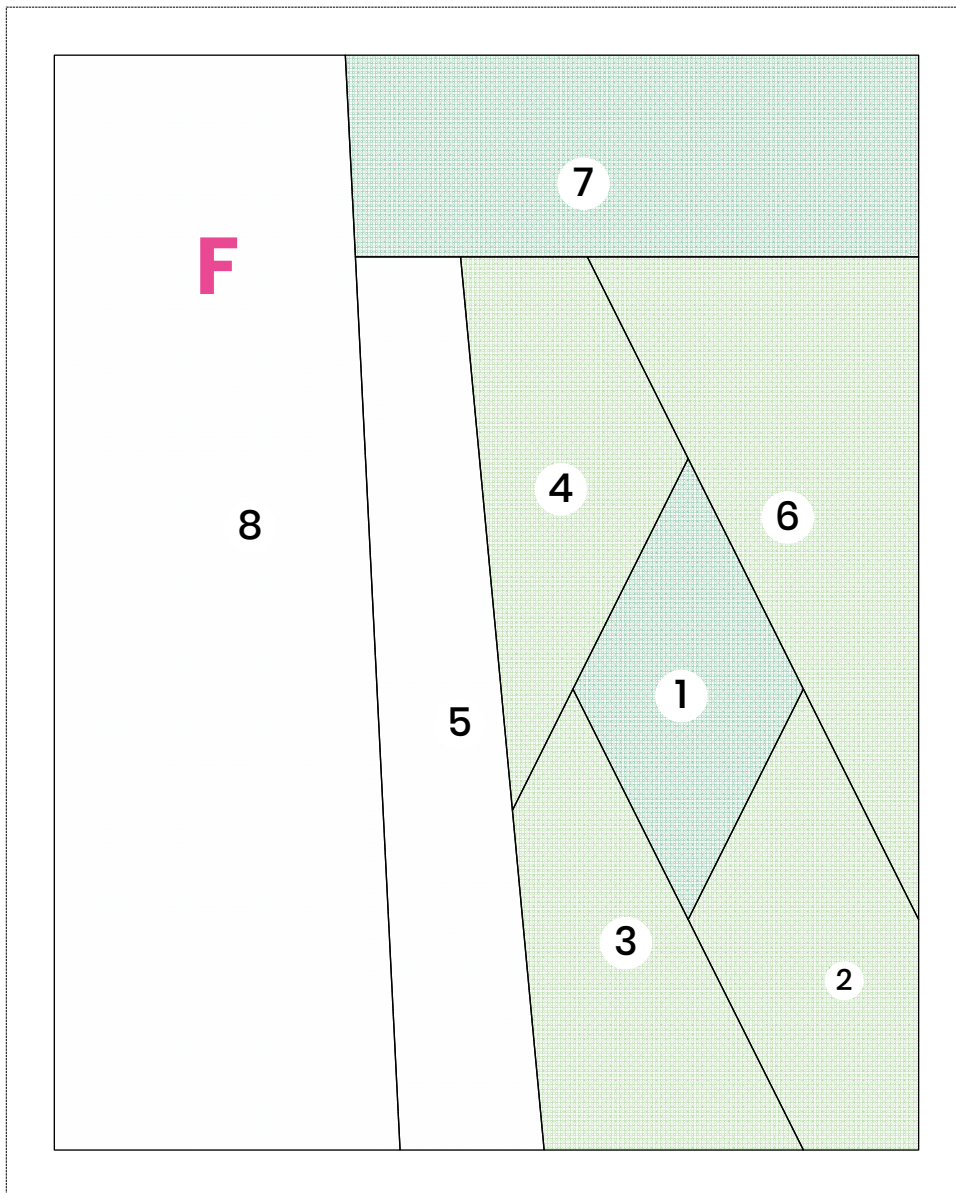


# Flower Pot 2 (2/2)
