Round About

This quilt is made with quarter circles. The placement of the smaller quarters gives a fun visual effect of squares throughout the quilt.

Size

Block 12 x 12 inch
Quilt 48 x 60 inch

Round About

Round About is made with quarter circles. The placement of the smaller quarters gives a fun visual effect of squares throughout the quilt.

Fabric Requirements

Here are the fabric requirements for the Round About quilt.

- **1FQ** in 13 colorful fabrics. I used these SKUs from the Lucky Bugs collection: 16443-32, 16443-82, 16554-85, 16555-38, 16555-46, 16556-33, 16556-45, 16556-56, 16557-37, 16557-43, 16557-83, 16558-44, 16558-56
- **2 yards** background fabric. I used 16555-09 from the Lucky Bugs collection.

Cutting

Before you start making the quarter circles you will need to cut the following:

- 20 times 1 x 6 inch strip (background)
- 20 times 1 x 6 1/2 inch strip (background)

These measurements include seam allowance.

Sewing

For this quilt you will need **20 small** quarter circle blocks and **60 large** quarter circle blocks. The templates for the convex and concave pieces of the quarter circles are included in the final pages of the pattern.

Trimming

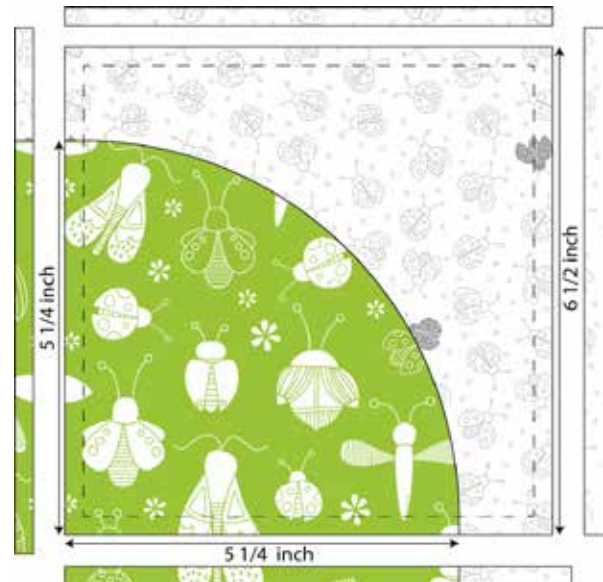
After sewing the blocks, and giving them a good press, you can go ahead and trim the blocks.

Take a close look at the following image for the measurements of the finished block. The length of the side of the quarter circle is also mentioned.

Adding strips

The block with the small quarter circle measures 6 inch. We will add two strips to make it the same size as the big quarter circle block.

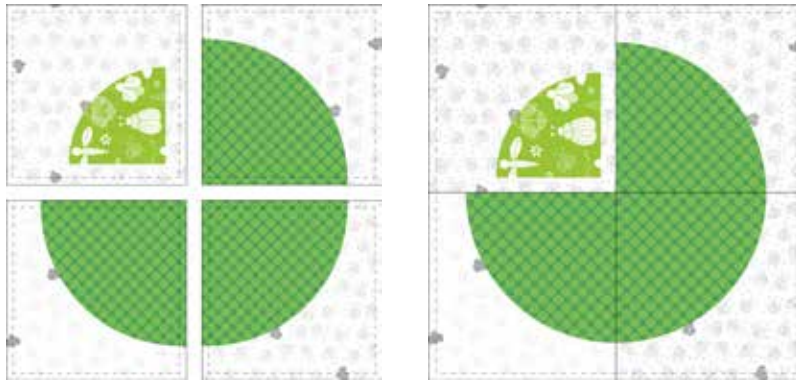

Round About – Assembly

When all the blocks are done you can start the assembly of the quilt.

First sew sets of four blocks, with three big blocks and 1 small block.

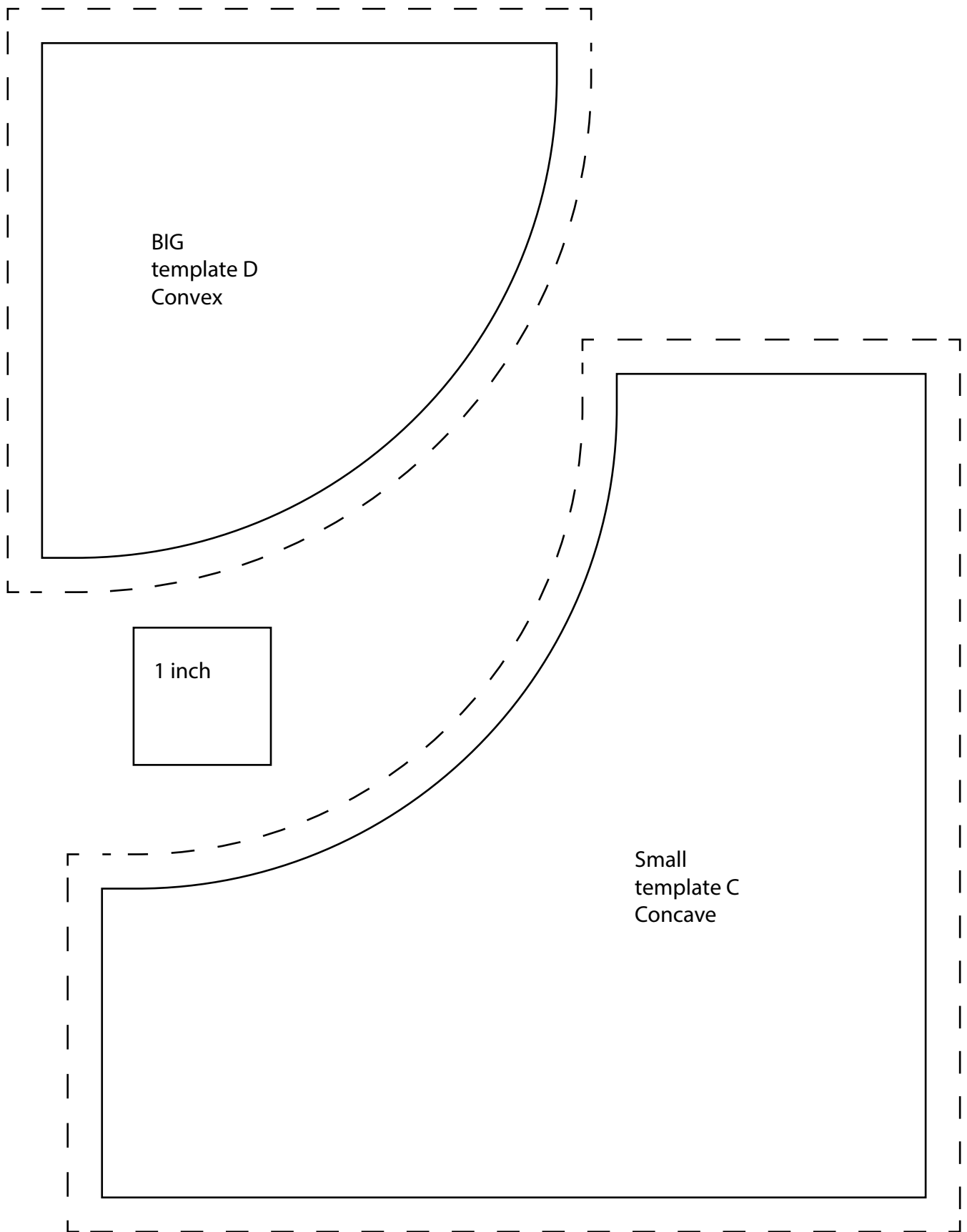


You will need to make 20 of these Round About blocks.

Now the fun part starts. You can start puzzling for the best layout of the blocks. The quilt you see below is one of the options. But of course there are many more possibilities with the blocks.
